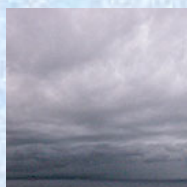
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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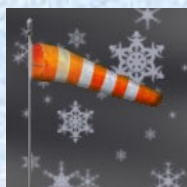
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Another low pressure system moves through the Bellingshausen Sea towards Averse Island. Clouds will move in this afternoon, producing some light snow until the evening. Winds will begin to pick up as precipitation becomes more intense. Gusts will persist throughout the day tomorrow as the low moves towards the Drake Passage.

Sky: Partly cloudy becoming cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): NE at 5-10, becoming NW at 10-15

Max Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 in snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): NW at 5-10, becoming 25-30 gusting 40

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 w/ mixed rain/snow and blowing snow with drops below 1

Wind (kts): NW at 25-30 gusting up to 40

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F
