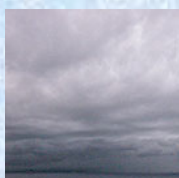

REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low moving towards the Drake Passage will produce cloud cover over station but track far enough away to keep winds light. Expect fair conditions with some snowfall in the evening. Tomorrow a trough progressing from the north and a high in the Weddell Sea will work to tighten the pressure gradient around station and elevate the winds.
