A decaying low moving through the Drake Passage extends its gradient to station, causing periods of elevated gusts today, though no snow is expected. Tomorrow a high pressure system surrounds part of the Antarctic Peninsula. Expect light winds and periods of snow in the afternoon.

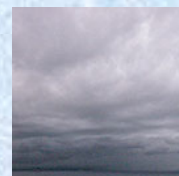
