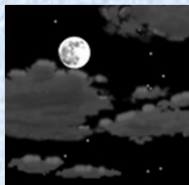
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A decaying low in the Drake Passage scatters cloud cover southwards towards Averse Island, causing periods of snow today. Tomorrow ridging adjacent to the Antarctic Peninsula will drive some cloud formation and transport moisture towards station.
