PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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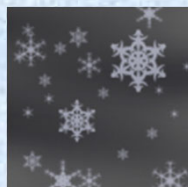
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Two consecutive lows moving in from the West will track with their centers along the coast of the Bellingshausen Sea. Large amounts of moisture transport is associated with the second low, generating increased snowfall as the pressure gradient tightens along the peninsula. Expect heavy precipitation tomorrow with low visibility throughout the day.

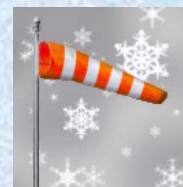

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with light snow, becoming 3-5 in snow and occasional mist

Wind (kts): NE at 5-10, becoming NW at 10-15

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 in snow and fog

Wind (kts): NW at 10-15

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ½-2 in mixed sleet/snow, mist, and blowing snow, frequent drops below ½

Wind (kts): NW-N at 15-20 gusting 25

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
