PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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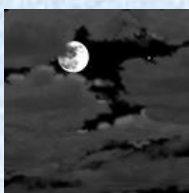
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure over the Antarctic Peninsula will continue to hold off low pressure systems moving in the Bellingshausen Sea. Tuesday will be cloudy with periods of light snow. Wednesday will dry out and become mostly clear. Winds will not pick up during the forecast due to a weak gradient over Palmer.
