**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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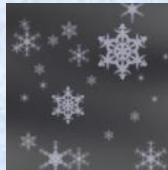
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure fills and dissipates to the west of Anvers island as a strong high pressure ridge builds to the northwest. Indications are for strong winds from the northeast starting out today around the low center with precipitation becoming more intermittent into tonight. Expect winds to decrease through tomorrow with light precipitation continuing under cloudy skies as temperatures trend colder.
