PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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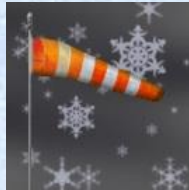
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A ridge of high pressure weakens over Anvers Island as a low-pressure system intensifies over the Bellingshausen Sea. Indications are for favorable conditions early today with increased cloud cover, winds, and precipitation by afternoon. Expect strong winds to persist tonight and through tomorrow with precipitation, heavy at times, reducing visibility significantly as temperatures trend warmer.
