A low-pressure system moves through the Drake Passage with an extensive cloud shield extending from the Antarctic Peninsula into the Weddell Sea, as evident on satellite imagery. Indications are for persistent precipitation, heavy at times, reducing visibility significantly today. Tonight through tomorrow expect cloud bases to lift as precipitation becomes intermittent as the low moves east.
