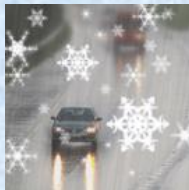
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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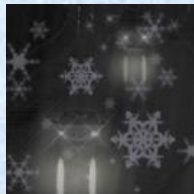
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low-pressure system moves through the Drake Passage with an extensive cloud shield extending from the Antarctic Peninsula into the Weddell Sea, as evident on satellite imagery. Indications are for persistent precipitation, heavy at times, reducing visibility significantly today. Tonight through tomorrow expect cloud bases to lift as precipitation becomes intermittent as the low moves east.

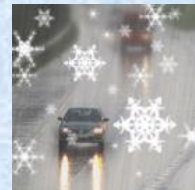

Visibility (SM): 4-6, with periods of 1-3 in rain/snow mix and mist

Wind (kts): N-NE-E 10-15 gusting to 20

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 2-4 in rain/snow mix and mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-15 gusting to 20

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, with periods of 3-5 in rain/snow mix and mist

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-15 gusting to 22

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F
