PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

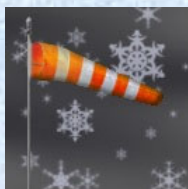

A low pressure system continues to make its way around the Antarctic Peninsula, causing impacts to the station throughout the next two days. Expect mostly cloudy conditions with periods of snow and fog today with the potential for gusty winds leading into the evening and throughout the day tomorrow.

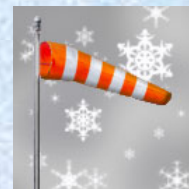

Visibility (SM): 1 due to snow and fog

Wind (kts): Light and variable

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ¼ due to snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): Light and variable becoming N 30 gusting 40

Min Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ¼ due to snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): N 30 gusting 40 becoming N 20 gusting 30.

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
