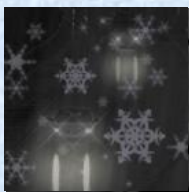

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Mostly Cloudy by late afternoon

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Light and variable

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -3°C / 27°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy, becoming Cloudy by midnight

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 in mixed rain and snow by midnight

Wind (kts): Light and variable, becoming NE 5-10 gusting 15 by midnight

Min Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 in rain

Wind (kts): NE 10-15 gusting 20, becoming N 20-30 gusting 40 by evening

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F
