A passing ridge of high pressure provides mild conditions today, with occasional light rainshowers. Tonight, a deep low will crash into the peninsula and cause howling winds and a rain/snow mix. Precipitation will change to all snow by morning, and these conditions will last through the end of the forecast period.
