**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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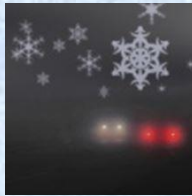
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure will track from the Antarctic Peninsula into the Weddell Sea, leaving Palmer Station under ridging for the forecast period. Friday will see cloudy skies and intermittent snowfall. Lower clouds will move in overnight and snow will fall and fog will form Saturday morning but will dissipate by the afternoon.
