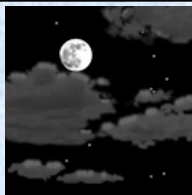
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Ridging continues to build over the Antarctic Peninsula pushing in some snow on Saturday. Clouds will move downstream, leaving Saturday and Sunday morning with fair weather. A strong low will begin to move in from Drake's Passage Sunday evening, bringing in more snow and strong winds.
