**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A strong low is tracking across the Antarctic Peninsula causing high winds and precipitation on Palmer Station. Conditions will continue for all of Tuesday before dying off overnight. Wednesday will see light winds and clearer skies with fog and mist, then snow will begin again in the afternoon.

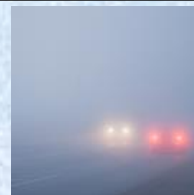

**Wind (kts):** NW 9-15 gusting 20

**Visibility (SM):** ½-2 with fog occasional 1-3 with snow

**Wind (kts):** Variable 5-9
