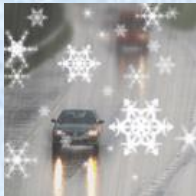
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A frontal boundary extending from a low in the Bellingshausen Sea will track across the Antarctic Peninsula, bringing cloud coverage and precipitation for all of Friday. The boundary will pass overnight leaving Saturday with no precipitation, but a potential for fog and mist.
