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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low Pressure centered over the Bellingshausen Sea piles moisture along the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula producing extensive cloud cover and mixed precipitation over the station. Expect a significant increase in wind speeds, as this low approaches from the west.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 3-5 in mixed rain and snow afternoon

Wind (kts): Variable 2-7

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -3°C / 27°F

Visibility (SM): 3-5 in mixed rain and snow, becoming 1/2-1 in early morning fog

Wind (kts): Variable 2-7, becoming SE 10-15 gusting to 25 by midnight

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1/2-1 in morning fog, becoming 3-5 in mixed rain and snow by mid morning

Wind (kts): NNE 25-35 gusting to 40, becoming NNE 15-20 gusting to 25 by evening

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
