A low over the Bellingshausen Sea continues to draw moisture towards the Antarctic Peninsula producing overcast skies, fog, and mixed precipitation. Over the next 48 hours, conditions are only expected to be markedly improved tomorrow morning, when weak ridging temporarily inhibits moisture advection.
