PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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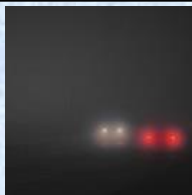
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will continue to weaken as it moves away from the Antarctic Peninsula, leaving Tuesday with partly cloudy skies and light winds. Fog is expected to form in the early morning hours but will dissipate before noon. A frontal boundary will move in on Wednesday and cause stronger winds and snowfall for most of the day.

Visibility (SM): ½-2 with fog becoming 1-3 with snow

Wind (kts): NW 5-10 becoming N 10-15 gusting 25
