PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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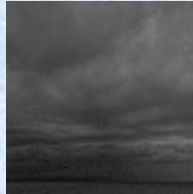
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Palmer Station will start the day with strong winds and snow flurries. A low pressure system will move in from the Bellingshausen Sea and bring precipitation on Thursday night into the morning. Winds will weaken throughout Thursday after the low moves closer to the Antarctic Peninsula, allowing for fog to form overnight. Friday will see light winds with fitful snow flurries.
