REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

As weakening low pressure tracks northeast into the Drake Passage, cloudy and snowy weather will give way to scattering skies and milder conditions after midday. Overnight and through tomorrow, gusty easterly winds will kick up and temperatures will dip.
