PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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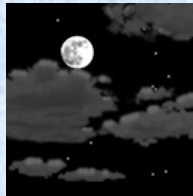
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Conditions will continue to improve on Saturday will mostly clear skies and light winds.
