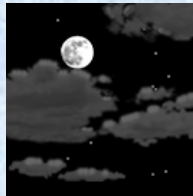
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system is currently tracking over the Antarctic Peninsula with clouds and light precipitation. As the low moves out, clouds will dissipate until another low moves in late on Thursday night bringing more clouds, precipitation and high winds on Palmer Station.
