Low pressure still lingers in the Bellingshausen Sea as another low will track along the east side of the Antarctic Peninsula. Saturday will see a tighten pressure gradient and higher wind speeds. As the low to the east moves further away, precipitation will follow behind it, falling fitfully on Sunday.

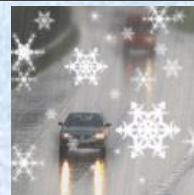
