REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Anvers Island remains between a low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea and a low pressure system in the Weddell Sea. Indications are for increasing pressure gradient with an uptick in winds from north-northwest by the afternoon today with persistent mixed precipitation as temperatures hover near freezing. Expect similar conditions through tomorrow as the low centers remain near stationary.

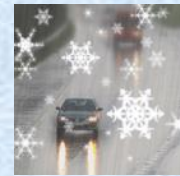
