**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Weather will start the morning with light winds, but a frontal boundary will track across the Antarctic Peninsula in the late morning. Winds will increase abruptly and remain at higher speeds until Tuesday afternoon. This front is dry and not much cloud coverage or precipitation will be associated with it. Winds will decrease in the afternoon of Tuesday and remain light for the rest of the forecast period.
