**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure in the Drake Passage will continue to track towards the Antarctic Peninsula keeping winds high at the start of the morning. The low will gradually weaken throughout the day and cause the winds to let up in the evening. Residual clouds and precipitation will pass overnight and winds will be light for all of Wednesday.
