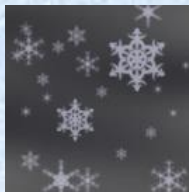
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

High pressure will hang out over Palmer Station for our day of Independence, keeping the weather pleasant. Low pressure will begin to move in from the Bellingshausen Sea on Friday. This low will weaken as it approaches the Antarctic Peninsula. Winds will not get too gusty, but heavy snow will occur Friday night.
