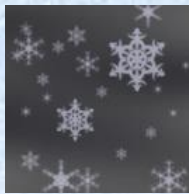
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will track across the Antarctic Peninsula from the Bellingshausen Sea. Palmer will see heavy snow and gusty winds for all of Sunday. Winds and snowfall will begin to decrease early Monday morning as the low moves into the Weddell Sea.

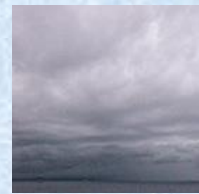

Wind (kts): SW at 15-20 gusting 25

Min Temp: -7°C / 19°F

Min Wind Chill: -16°C / 3°F

Wind (kts): W at 10-15 becoming NE at 5-10

Max Temp: -4°C / 25°F
