**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Thursday will start the day under high pressure with light winds and partly cloudy skies. A low will move in from the Bellingshausen Sea late in the evening. Winds will pick up in speeds, but precipitation will not start consistently until Friday morning. Those conditions will last until late in the evening on Friday when the low moves into the Weddell Sea.

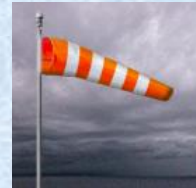

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional 3-5 with snow

**Wind (kts):** NE at 10-15 becoming 20-25 gusting 40

**Max Temp:** -9°C / 16°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -19°C / -2°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasional snow flurries

**Wind (kts):** NE at 20-25 gusting 30

**Min Temp:** -5°C / 23°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -15°C / 5°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 with snow

**Wind (kts):** N at 15-20 gusting 25 becoming SE at 10-15

**Max Temp:** -5°C / 23°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -14°C / 7°F
