PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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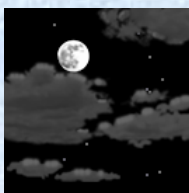
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will track across the Antarctic Peninsula throughout the day Friday. Winds will slowly taper off, but snow will continue to fall until the late evening. High pressure will begin to move in behind the low. Saturday will see lighter winds with intermittent precipitation throughout the day.
