Winds and snowfall will continue through Saturday as low pressure tracks across the Antarctic Peninsula. Sunday morning, winds will decrease substantially and snowfall will cease as high pressure builds behind the low.

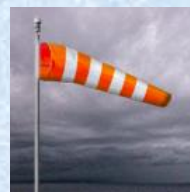

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with snow flurries

Wind (kts): SW at 10-15 gusting 20

Min Temp: -10°C / 13°F

Min Wind Chill: -19°C / -2°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional snow flurries

Wind (kts): W at 10-15 becoming N at 10-15

Max Temp: -6°C / 21°F

Min Wind Chill: -15°C / 5°F
