**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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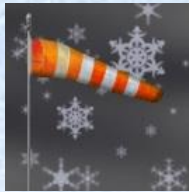
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Yet another low pressure system is making its way across the Antarctic Peninsula. Winds will start gusty on Monday morning but slowly decrease throughout the day as the low moves into the Weddell Sea. There will be a brief period of winds overnight before they die off on Tuesday morning.

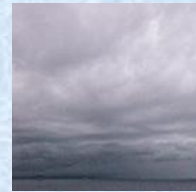
