PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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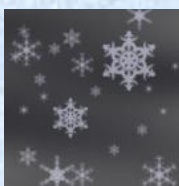
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Back to the routine pattern of high pressure today and low pressure moving in tomorrow. Saturday will start with light winds and with little clouds. As the low pushes in from the Bellingshausen Sea, snow will begin to fall in the evening. Winds will steadily increase and will be strongest Saturday afternoon.
