REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Station remains in the downstream of a ridge as a strong high moves in from the East. The high and an adjacent low wrapping around the Antarctic Peninsula will maintain a tight pressure gradient around Anvers Island. Wind will begin picking up overnight and stay elevated throughout tomorrow.
