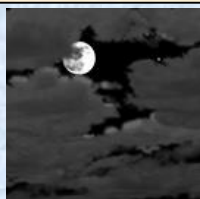
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will continue to move away from the Antarctic Peninsula as high pressure builds behind it. Weather over the next few days will be fairly tame with light winds and a brief period of precipitation overnight.
