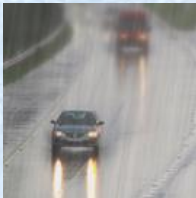

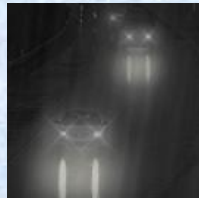
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system will track from the Bellingshausen Sea into Drake's Passage. Although the low will not move over Palmer Station, it will bring in precipitation fitfully and tighten the gradient enough for some elevated wind speeds overnight. Thursday will see the winds decrease with another round of precipitation in the evening.
