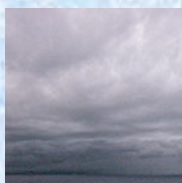

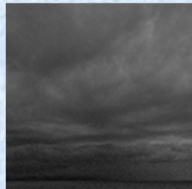
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system developing along Cape Horn strengthens its pressure gradient against the Andes Mountains. The low moves southwards through the Drake Passage, sweeping precipitation along northern half of the Antarctic Peninsula.

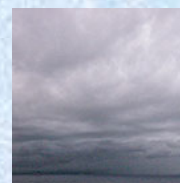
