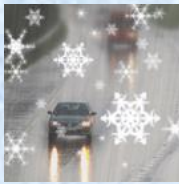

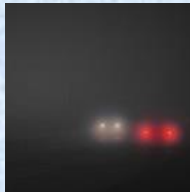
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system will slowly track through Drake's Passage, bringing in precipitation before it moves out to the east. Fog will be present late on Sunday and remain overnight. Monday will see similar conditions to Sunday with light winds and brief periods of flurries as the temperatures drop.

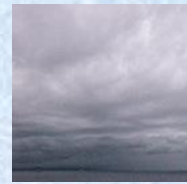
