REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system has stalled to the northwest of Anvers Island, and troughs “pinwheeling” around it are expected to produce intermittent precipitation and gusty winds for most of the period. The low appears to fill and recede slightly northwest late tomorrow.
