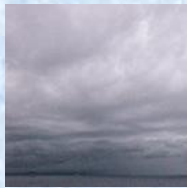
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A decaying low pressure system continues to dissipate and move east-northeastward along the southern tip of South America as a high pressure ridge builds over the northern Antarctic Peninsula. Indications are for favorable conditions with cloudy to mostly cloudy skies, good visibility, and light winds through the forecast period.
