PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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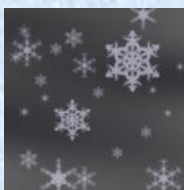
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will track into across the Bellingshausen Sea towards the Antarctic Peninsula. As the low moves closer, the gradient will tighten causing strong winds and precipitation. A frontal boundary will move across Palmer Station Saturday, keeping precipitation and winds for the entire day.
