## PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A decaying low continues to produce some gusty winds and snowfall across station today. Tomorrow a developed low pressure system tracks through the Bellingshausen Sea towards the Averse Island. A squall will sweep across the Antarctic Peninsula tomorrow, causing elevated gusts and significant snow/rain showers throughout the day.

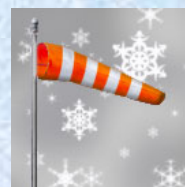

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 with snow

**Wind (kts):** NW 8-12 gusting 20

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -8°C / 18°F

**Sky:** Mostly Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted with drops to 2-4 with snow

**Wind (kts):** NW 5-10, becoming N-NE at 15-20 gusting 30

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 14°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 with mixed rain/snow and mist with occasional drops below 1

**Wind (kts):** N 20-25 gusting 35

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 15°F
