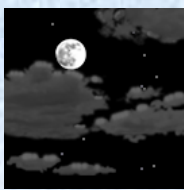
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will begin to move away from the Antarctic Peninsula and high pressure will build behind it. Precipitation will end by midday on Monday. After precipitation ends, weather will clear up with mostly sunny skies and light winds for the next two days.
