PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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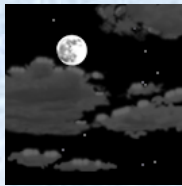
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will move down from Drake's Passage towards Palmer Station, bringing in clouds on Friday before moving out overnight. On Saturday, a second low will move in from the Bellingshausen Sea and produce a frontal boundary that will track over Anvers Island. The front will have snow and high winds speeds as it moves over Palmer.
