**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low will track across the Bellingshausen Sea towards the Antarctic Peninsula. The low will produce a frontal boundary that will bring snow and high winds for a brief period. After the low passes, high pressure will build in, leaving Palmer Station with light winds and intermittent snow.
