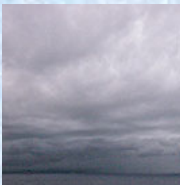

REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A decaying low moving up along the Antarctic Peninsula pushes moisture towards Averse Island, causing some cloud and fog today and tonight. Expect periods of occasional light snow throughout the forecast period. Tomorrow a low near Cape Horn extends its tight pressure gradient towards station, elevating the winds tomorrow.
