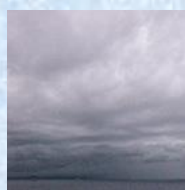

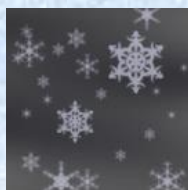
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system will move in from the north into the Drake Passage. The low will bring in moisture that will create clouds and snow. The gradient will tighten causing gusty winds for the day. Snow and wind speeds will taper off as the low decays and pushes to the east on Sunday.

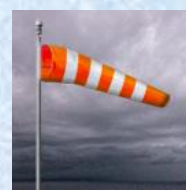
