REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will slowly track across the Antarctic Peninsula, keeping winds gusty with snowfall for all of Sunday. Ridging will briefly move in behind the low on Sunday night, calming the winds. A second low will move over Palmer Station and cause winds to pick up in the afternoon.
